

## INTERPIG 2022 – SUMMARY



The source of the information is the InterPIG group data base, where SIP has been providing information about Spain since 2006. All the results are shown in live weight.

This document is a summary of the most significant results of the main European countries in pig production.

It compares the results of Spain (SP) with the group EU4 (France, Germany, Denmark, and Netherlands).

### Results 2021

The (net) **Sales price** in Spain (123 c€/kg) has been 13 c€ higher than the EU4 group (110 c€/kg).

The **Production cost** in Spain (121 c€/kg) has been 6 c€ lower than the EU4 group (127 c€/kg).

As a result, the **Economic margin** has been clearly favourable to Spain, with a difference of 19 c€/kg (Spain: +1 c€/kg – EU4 group: -17 c€/kg).

The advantage of Spain in the Production cost is based on the Housing and Management cost.

In feed cost there is a disadvantage, due to the feed price.

### Evolution 2020 – 2021

The **Sales Price** in 2021 has been lower than in 2020, in Spain -7 c€/kg and in the EU4 group -13 c€/kg.

The **production cost** has increased, in Spain +13 c€/kg and in the EU4 group +10 c€/kg.

The resultant **Economic margin** has been reduced in a significant but similar way in both groups: in Spain -21 c€/kg and in the European group -23 c€/kg.
